The GORDA web site is located at: <http://gorda.di.uminho.pt>. The website has a solid structure, already described in D6.1, and is comprised of sections containing the project outline, project goals, project partners and a community section.

A brief description of GORDA is presented when the user reaches the front page. The description contains an introduction, support and funding related data as well as contacts and project duration. The objectives and consortium sections complement this description by describing the goals of the project and the partners which are responsible for the project. These sections of the site are somewhat static and change little over the time. They are intended to present the viewer as much info as possible about the project itself.

As the project evolves, some of its "products" are released to the community. For instance, software packages created may be put into this section, becoming available to any viewer that wishes to download them. This section grows over the time as public related data is produced in the project and is released into the open source community.

A section named Library also exists and is only available to authenticated users. It holds private documents which are only available to the project partners. For example, the DoW is stored in this section.

Finally, there is also a section of news, which holds news about the project. Workshops, Conferences, software packages, and events related information is announced in this section.
