A registration form was drafted by CEMR and approved by the Steering Group. All registrations were then pre-approved by CEMR and discussed by the Steering Group when deemed necessary.

All stakeholders willing to join the network were invited to fill in the form, which provided significant information to other members, such as: the type of organisation (LRAs, university, business, civil society); their interests, the field they are working on or wish to work on, and how they could contribute to the AFE-INNOVNET.

Good practices were open to the public; however only members of the AFE-INNOVNET were able to submit them.

The content

The deliverable 3.4 contained the following information about the members of the AFE-INNOVNET thematic network: name of the organisation; type of organisation; country; official website; and the name of the contact person. For privacy issues, contact details were removed from the document.
