Project's logotype (full version) designed with the following explanations concerning the graphics and contents:

- Three coherent colours were chosen: the blue for serious and institutional character and connection with ocean, the grey to make lean with the shipbuilding word, and a touch of "warm" yellow recalling the European stars.
- The round shape is evocating a clock and so the shared shiptime within Europe. It remains opened to express that other partners could still join the Project.
- The signature, for the full version logotype, is deliberately in two colours ("Euro" and "fleets") to focus on loose integration, as the EUROFLEETS project aims to coordinate the European fleets and not to become a trade mark.


