One task of COFASP is the collection and analysis of research projects on aquaculture, fisheries and seafood processing funded at European/national level, carried out by European Countries in the three major FAO marine Areas related with EU (FAO Area 27; FAO Area 34; FAO Area 37).

- 2,526 public funded projects from 2003 to 2013
- Cross-cutting projects are only 14% of projects
- Main cross-cutting issue: quality and safety of food
- Typically national projects are 1-3 years in duration

The database will be further updated with projects funded until 2015.

All collected data are publicly accessible through an online geodatabase developed by CNR (Italy) allowing for easy search of all projects carried out on a specific issue/area.

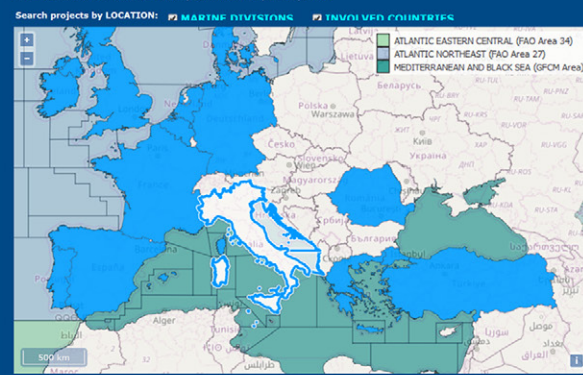

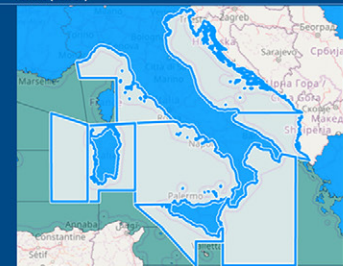
